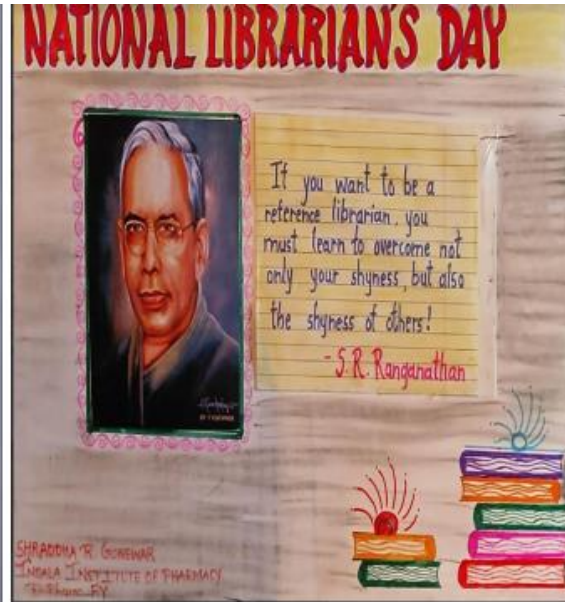
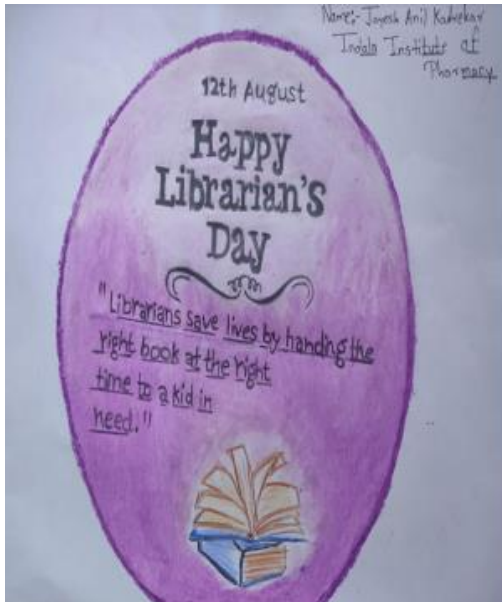
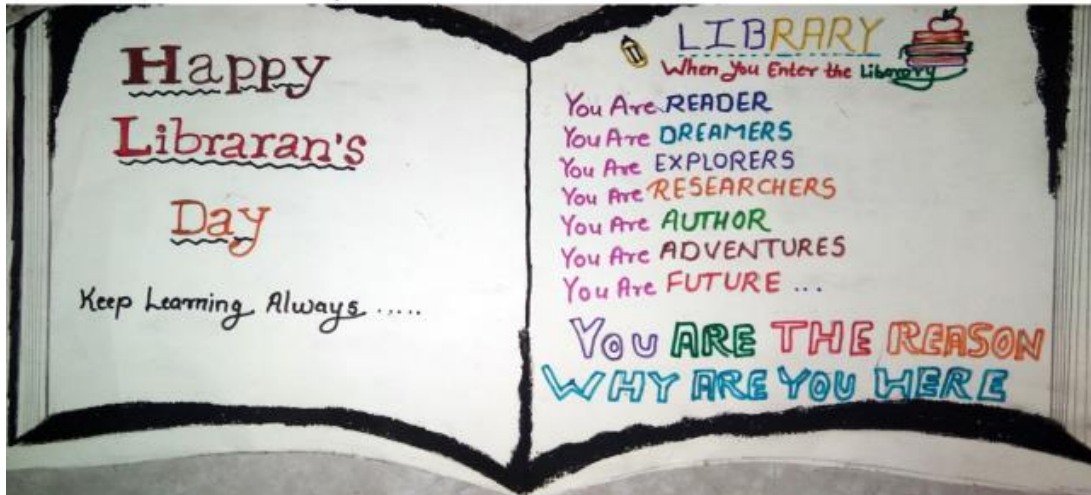
On this occasion, we were invited all Students, Teachers & Other Staff to participate ‘Slogan and Poster Making’ activity. Many students and staff took participate.

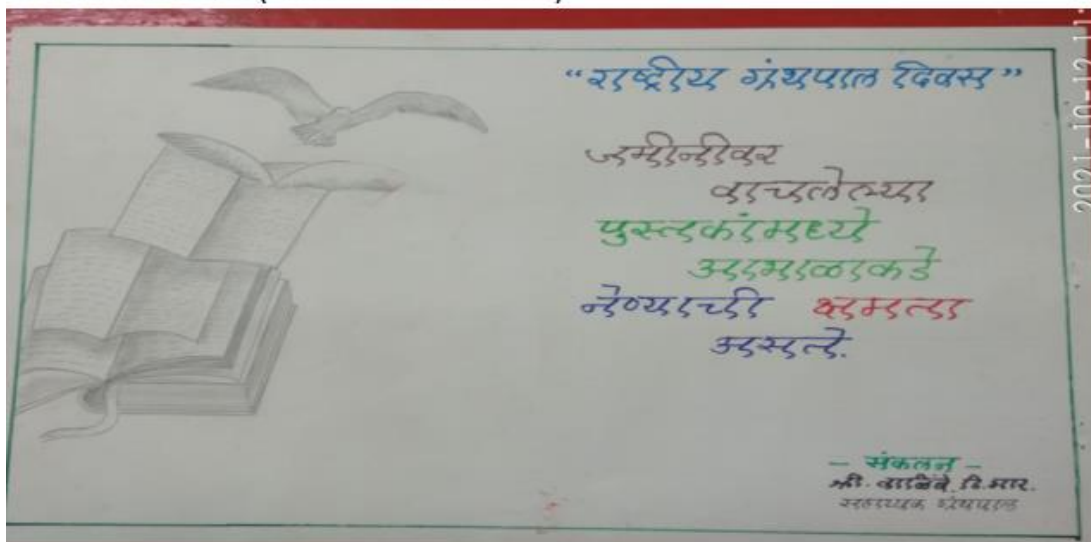

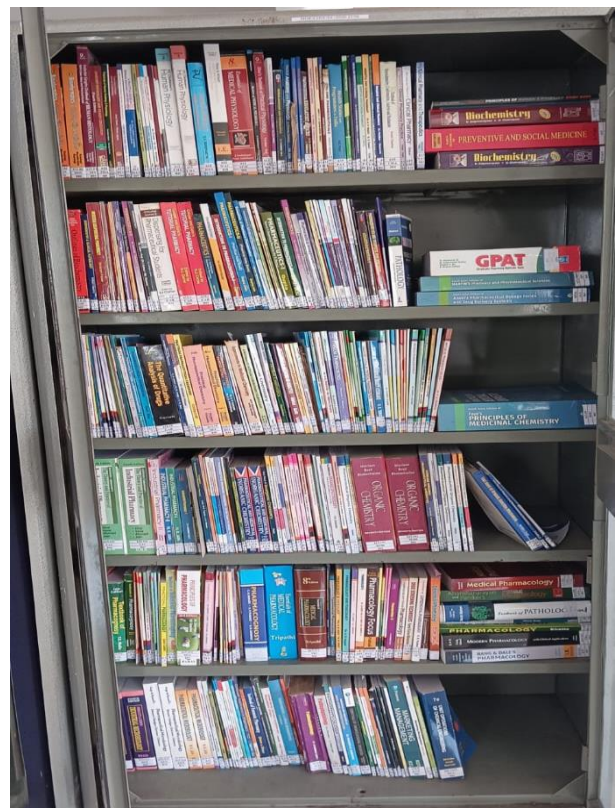


New Arrival of Books in Library
